



Oxenhope CE Primary School PE and Sport Premium Impact Statement 2015-2016

Since 2013 the Government has provided additional funding for schools to allow them to continue to develop Physical Education and sports provision and to help them increase pupil participation in sporting activity.

In 2015-2016 Oxenhope CE Primary School received £8000. This funding was used to enable the children to take part an increased range of physical and sporting activities across the school, as well as to engage in competitive events with other schools. We focused on securing sustainable improvements to the quality of teaching, learning and assessment through engaging in high quality CPD and providing expert coaching.
