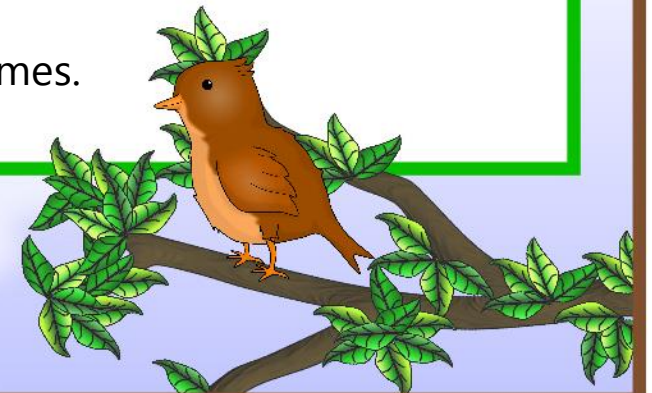


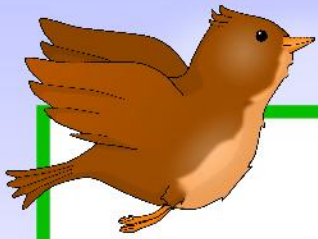


## New Nest –September 2019

As 'The Nest' continues to go from strength to strength, we endeavour to improve our facilities. The Nest is now located at the end of the main corridor, in the entrance to the hall.
