We will be learning the place values of numbers to 20. We will read, write and order the numbers and make the teen numbers by adding ones to a ten.

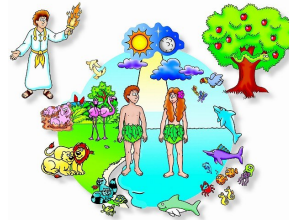
#### RE
