

# Homework Year 3

Homework for year 3 will be given **25.9.19**. However, if you wish to do some work with your child they can take something from the revision box this week and return on Wednesday. We are currently working on baseline assessing all children in Year 3 for reading to ensure their reading book is correct. Books will be changed and ready for **25.9.19** as well.

## **Half termly topic work.**

At the beginning of each half term, I will let you know what our topic is going to be and send you a list of ideas for a project based piece of work. Please choose something from the list (or pick an idea of your own if there's something you're burning to do) and complete this at home over the weeks of the half term. Projects will be due in the Friday before we break up for each half term. This will give us chance to display these and for each child to share their work with the class.

## **Spelling**

Spellings will be sent home in your child's homework book each Wednesday and tested the following Wednesday. Your child will receive 10 spellings each week. For most children, this will be 5 from the statutory list for Year 3 and 4, and 5 pattern based words from our spelling lessons that week. If your child's spelling work will be different, I will have had a conversation with you regarding this.

**Maths** Each week, I will set mathematics homework for your child to complete. They should also spend time on Times Table Rock Stars working on their times tables. Their log in details are stuck in the front of their homework books.

Occasionally, I may send other maths homework which should be completed within the week and returned the following Friday.

**English** Reading and spelling are the only pieces of English homework your child needs to complete weekly.

Occasionally, I may send other English, grammar or punctuation homework which should be completed within the week and returned the following Friday.

**Reading** Your child will have a reading book and yellow reading record book. Each time you hear them read at home, please write in their record book. Once a book is finished, your child will be asked to complete a task based around what they have read. Once this has been returned to school, they will then be able to change their book.

**Revision** There is a box of activities in the classroom which your child is free to take at any time. These will be predominantly maths and GPS activity sheets. Your child may complete as many or as few of these as they wish.

**Responsibility** In year 3, we encourage the children to start taking some responsibility for their homework. Your child must have their reading book and record book in school every day and their homework book must be in school each Wednesday showing evidence of the work they have done at home during that week. This will, at a minimum, be their spelling work. They may also wish to work on their times tables in their book and may complete any other work in here too although nothing else is compulsory.
