SCIENCE, GEOGRAPHY, HISTORY, ART and DT. Volcanoes.

In Geography, research about Mount Vesuvius. Link this to some History learning about what happened in Pompeii.

Perhaps you could create a papier mache volcano and paint it to look realistic.

If you want to get messy, you could create your own eruption by using this recipe or a similar one you might find on line.

1. Water
2. 3-4 Tbs of baking soda at least (if you do 4-6, it makes it extra foamy and will do 2-3 eruptions)
3. 1 tsp of washing up liquid
4. 1/2 oz to 2 oz of washable paint, depending on the intensity of the colour desired

5. 1 cup (8 oz) of Vinegar to start with per eruption.

Maybe you'd like to paint a volcano? At school, we're going to use water colours.

You can present your volcano learning in any way you like and can focus on the subjects which interest you the most. We'd like you to do 3 pieces of work about volcanoes this week.

OUTDOOR LEARNING Frames. Create a frame from card and take a photograph through it. What scenery can you capture in your frame? You could cut an interesting shape like a heart or maybe just a wavy edged frame might look nice. You can experiment and see which you like.
