Home Learning

Dear parents and carers,

As promised here is some more information about how home learning at Oxenhope will work.

I have attached to this letter our Home Learning Offer. This will outline how we will be moving forward and give you an overview of how it will work.

We are moving towards using two learning platforms. For years reception to year 2 we will be using Seesaw – something which I know reception and year 1 parents are familiar with. In years 3-6 we will be using class DoJo. There is more information within the Home Learning Offer about how this will work. We are hoping to roll this out to all families from Monday 18th of January. Don't worry we will still use the website and YouTube next week too until the transition has taken place.

The reason for this is to allow us to better monitor children's learning and access, ensure that uploading of work is streamlined and efficient, that marking and feedback can be quality and effective and finally that children can access learning safely from a secure learning platform.

We will be sending out login details next week and which devices are best to use. Every child will receive a class DoJo or Seesaw login even if they are accessing school as this will support home learning should a child need to isolate. We will still offer paper copies of learning for those who need it and you can photograph work and upload it to the relevant platform for staff to see.

I do however want to reiterate something I have put in the Home Learning Offer. Home learning is **hard and you are doing amazing things**. I absolutely take my hat off to parents at the moment. We are prioritising mental health and wellbeing and this includes parents. You can only do what you can do. I will not be berating parents for not completing all home learning tasks with their children as long as some effort is being made. If you need us to speak directly to your child we can. I have had many messages saying 'my child won't do their learning' you are not on your own and we can help. Please speak to us, please come to us. I know we are busy but this takes priority.
