

This week we are having a Geography focus. We are going to be looking at comparing and contrasting Greece to the U.K and looking at lots of different facts about both places.

Here is a guideline to help you with your work:

Day	Tasks to complete
Monday	<p>Looking at the 7 continents of the world.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In year 3, you should already have some knowledge of the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world. However, if you have forgotten them then we are going to do lots of work around them today. <p>Starter - write down any continents you think you may know?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is a PowerPoint on the website that looks at the different continents in the world, I would like you to have a look at this and complete the 7 continent leaflet that is on the website. However, if you don't have access to a printer, you could set this work out in a book the same and just follow the format. <p>Good luck! ☺</p>
Tuesday	<p>The 5 world's oceans.</p> <p>Recap - get an adult or a family member to test you on the 7 continents. Clues can be given if you are struggling.</p> <p>Following on from yesterday's lesson we are going to look at the 5 oceans.</p> <p>Activity 1: Look at the PowerPoint that is available on the website. Read this carefully and make some short notes if you would like to while reading this to help with your work.</p> <p>Activity 2: Using the world map (available on the website), I would like you to complete the activity sheet that asks you to label the oceans.</p> <p>Challenge: Write a paragraph about your favourite ocean and do some further research about a species of fish that live there.</p> <p>Two of my favourite animals are dolphins and sharks and I would love to see some information on these animals! ☺</p>
Wednesday	<p>World map work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I would like you to use the blank world map and try and write on the map any countries you may know. You may only know 1 or 2 and that is absolutely fine (do not panic), this is to see what you know before the lesson. Next, I would like you to use your Geography skills of looking at a world map, to identify where the UK and Greece would be on this map. I would like you to colour the UK red and Greece blue.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I need to know the capital cities of both countries and see this labelled on the map, too. Remember, the UK is split into different countries – what are they? What are their capital cities? <p>To finish: I would like you to look at the world map and look at where different countries join together. You could either: 1) Get an adult to cut these countries out and create a jigsaw or use another blank map to locate as many countries as you can without looking.</p>
Thursday	<p>I would like you to look at the different traditions they have in both Greece and the UK.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evil eye – Greek tradition• Guy Fawkes – UK Tradition. <p>I would like you to make some notes on this, print some pictures out if possible and explain why they celebrate each of these things.</p>
Friday	<p>To finish or expand on anything you have done so far. Use this time to have some 'you time'. You may like to do some Art and copy the UK and Greek flags, some reading, some lego building or something to help you relax.</p> <p>Next week, we are going to look at presenting all our findings in a creative way! 😊</p> <p>Have a lovely weekend, Year 3 x</p>
