SUMMER 1

Our topic is 'Bright Lights and Big Cities. This term we will be learning about the Queen' and London. We will step back in time and learn about what happened in the Great Fire of London. Where did it start and where did it end?



There's also someone new in town! Paddington Bear is coming all the way from Peru to visit Oxenhope. Paddington is eager to tell us what he knows about London.



Handwriting

We will be practising writing using joined up letters. Please practice at home as often as you can. Your child should be forming their letters correctly and writing on the line.

Maths

We are learning the place value of numbers to 50 and beyond. We are making numbers in tens using equipment. We are counting in 2s, and 10s and 5s. We are breaking numbers up into tens and ones. How many tens are in 35? How many ones? Can you represent this number using different equipment?



Science

We will be investigating Different materials such as wood, plastic, glass, fabric and their properties. Are they rigid or flexible? Are they transparent?

Paddington Bear needs a new hat to visit rainy London. Which material would be most suitable?

RE

We will be learning about Judaism and comparing the life of a Jewish child to that of a Christian child.

How are their lives similar? How are their lives different? Which day is special to them? How do they celebrate?



ENGLISH

The focus will be writing letters both informal and formal. We will be writing postcards to Paddington's Aunt in Peru, Invitations to her majesty Queen

Elizabeth and replying to letters that we will receive in class. Perhaps you could encourage your child to write a letter to a relative or friend.

Home learning

Children will be asked to complete daily reading at home, a weekly spelling activity, and a homework task of your choice from the list provided. The focus in Year 1 for catching up on what learning has been missed this year is reading and phonics. We are providing extra lessons in class.
