

# Year 2 Horkinstone Class Term 3a



This half term we're learning about space! We're focusing on the planet Mars and discovering if there could be life on Mars. We will be learning about recent discoveries and explorations and writing information texts about what we've learnt, in living memory and beyond living memory.



In science we will be learning about what makes plants grow, and investigating hydroponics.
