Maths

We will be learning simple multiplication and division facts. E.g.

There are 10 birds in each tree.

There are four trees.

There are forty birds altogether.

There are 10 biscuits.

There are 5 children.

How many biscuits will each child receive?

RE

Our focus is 'belonging'. Who am I and what does it mean to belong? We will be learning about Christenings, belonging to a faith, school, team.

Homework
