Reading books

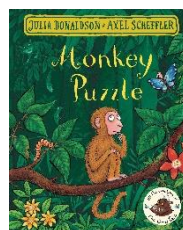
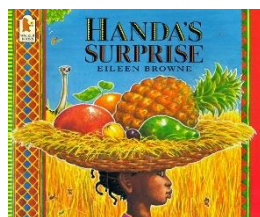
