Here's how it works... If you wish to join the 100-Club, you purchase a membership for **£12**. You will then be randomly allocated a number(s). Each number will be entered into 6 half-termly draws this academic year 2021 - 2022.

The prize fund will be distributed as set out in the rules; the more people enter - the bigger the prizes will be!

All participants **must be over 16**. You may purchase up to 10 numbers. You can buy for family and friends. This could be the perfect present for those hard to buy for relatives! Something different and unique!

## 100 CLUB RULES

### PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds which will be paid into the Friends of Oxenhope School bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school. These requests are to provide equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

### RULES

1. For a cost of £12 per year you will be randomly allocated one number starting at 1.
2. A committee representative will randomly allocate numbers to those who join the club using an electronic random number generator. Members of the 100 club will be notified of their number(s) by email from the email account [Friends@oxenhope.bradford.sch.uk](mailto:Friends@oxenhope.bradford.sch.uk)
3. There is no limit to the number of numbers that may be sold in total. However, the club will not run if under 60 tickets are sold. If the club is cancelled, any money paid will be returned in full to payees.
4. A draw will be made every half-term with 3 prizes per draw. The 6 draws this academic year will take place either in school assembly or virtually in the presence of 2 committee members on the following dates to coincide with the end of each half term...
  - o Thursday 21st October
  - o Thursday 16th December
  - o Thursday 17th February
  - o Thursday 7th April
  - o Thursday 26th May
  - o Thursday 21st July
5. Numbers will be drawn using an electronic number generator for example <https://pickerwheel.com/tools/random-number-generator/>. All numbers will be entered into each draw regardless of whether that number has won a prize on a previous draw – so you have 6 opportunities to win in the academic year. Once a number is drawn, it will be removed from the draw for that half term only – so one number can only win once each half term.
6. 50% of the income will be given to Oxenhope CE Primary via the normal request process. The other 50% will form the prize fund.
7. The prize fund will be apportioned equally to the 6 half-termly draws. Three prizes will be apportioned as: 1st prize 50%, 2nd and 3rd prize 25% each.

Examples:-

  - a. If 180 tickets are sold; £1800 of income will be taken. £900 will go to school. £900 will be shared across the 6 half-termly draws - £150 per draw. The first number drawn will get £75, 2 other winners will get £37.50 each.
  - b. If 120 tickets are sold; £1200 of income will be taken. £600 will go to school. £600 will be shared across the 6 half-termly draws - £100 per draw. The first number drawn will get £50, 2 other winners will get £25 each.
  - c. If 60 tickets are sold; £600 of income will be taken. £300 will go to school. £300 will be shared across the 6 half-termly draws - £50 per draw. The first number drawn will get £25, 2 other winners will get £12.50 each.
8. The Friends of Oxenhope School committee reserve the right to increase the number of prizes if more than 250 numbers are sold.
9. The 100 Club is open to all parents, carers, staff and those wishing to support Oxenhope CE Primary School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
10. Numbers are limited to ten per household.

11. Payments must be made by ParentPay, cheque or BACS transfer before 19th October 2021. No refunds will be given. No late entries will be permitted.
12. The prize winners will be notified by email from the following email account [Friends@oxenhope.bradford.sch.uk](mailto:Friends@oxenhope.bradford.sch.uk). Prize money will be paid by BACS transfer or cheque within one week of the draw.
13. The name and numbers for the winners of each draw will be published in a Friends email from school, on the School Facebook page and school website.
14. The 100 Club will be run by the Friends of Oxenhope School (Registered Charity Number 1162507). In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
15. Membership of the 100 club ceases at the end of the summer term 2022.
16. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Friends of Oxenhope School after six months.
